



# All Ireland Scholarships

## Republic of Ireland

Established by JP McManus in 2008, the All Ireland Scholarship is awarded to 125 of the highest – achieving students per year, with a minimum of two students from each of the 32 counties. The scholarship consists of payments of €6,750 per annum for the duration of the students' undergraduate degree.

To be eligible you must meet the criteria listed below, additionally, scholarship winners generally achieve high leaving cert results e.g. 500+ points.



### AM I ELIGIBLE?

- You must be attending a non-fee-paying school
- You must be sitting the Leaving Certificate Examination for the first time
- You must be in receipt of a third level education maintenance grant from Student Universal Support Ireland (SUSI), having applied for same on or prior to the SUSI closing date. More information on the SUSI grant can be found at [susi.ie](http://susi.ie)
- You cannot be a recipient of another third level education scholarship

### HOW DO I APPLY?

There is NO application process for students based in the Republic of Ireland, if eligible, you will be contacted by the Dept. of Further and Higher Education, Research, Innovation and Science following the release of the leaving certificate results.

## Northern Ireland

To be eligible you must meet the criteria listed below.



### AM I ELIGIBLE?

- You must be in receipt of the Education Maintenance Allowance
- You must be attending a grant aided post primary school or further education college
- You must sit the A Level Examinations or BTEC Examinations for the first time
