


The Business Support team may well be able to help local businesses and potential entrepreneurs offering a range of services and current mentoring opportunities.

Enterprise North West





The NI Small Business Loan Fund (NISBLF) is part of Invest NI's "Access to Finance" strategy and provides funding in the form of loans for startups and existing businesses. Funding can be provided for a range of purposes including Working Capital, Asset Purchases, Growth Finance, StartUp Costs, Match Funding etc.

Ulster Community Investment Trust Ltd

If you've got an idea that could make a difference in your community - to change something by solving a problem or creating an opportunity, the Ulster Community Investment Trust Ltd can provide a loan to make it happen. Loans can be provided for social enterprise and community projects, including charities and faith-based initiatives.

Unitd


