




Ever thought how good it would be to spend all your time on the subject you love the most rather than dividing up your time with a range of different ones?


If you are someone who would love a job in the creative industries and area passionate about your art and design studies above all else, then this course could be perfect for you!


## **UAL Level 3 Extended Diploma in Art & Design** (Design Crafts)

Equivalent to 3 A Levels in Art & Design over 2 years.

This full-time course attracts school leavers after GCSE or AS / A Level study, as well as students from other disciplines wishing to specialise in art and design in an alternative format to A Levels or to reskill in a more creative pathway.

This course provides students with a significant portfolio of work in a wide range of specialist practice for application to a Foundation Art and Design course should you need more time to make up your mind on pathway choices, or to a HND or Degree course if you've decided on your future pathway.

Our UAL courses are accredited by the University of the Arts London Awarding Body.




We work with a diverse range of themes and projects in order to build up your skills and introduce you to a wide range of creative opportunities.



#### **Course Details**

The course is made up of 13 units of specialist study over two years.

Year 1 = Diploma This year is about exploring and developing new skills.

- 1. An introduction to visual language in art and design
- 2. An introduction to research skills in art and design
- 3. An introduction to critical and contextual awareness in art and design
- 4. An introduction to materials, processes and technical skills in art and design
- 5. An integrated approach to 2D problem-solving
- 6. An integrated approach to 3D problem-solving
- 7. An integrated approach to time-based problem-solving
- 8. Developing an art and design project \*
- 9. Opportunities for progression in art and design

- A series of introductory skills units are followed by more specialist units allowing students to choose from a range of 2D and 3D pathways.
- The year continues with the development of a personal project written by the students to their chosen theme and specialist pathway. This is externally assessed\*.
- Students also learn about careers within the creative arts through talks from visiting speakers, gallery visits and careers research.







#### **Course Details**

Year 2 = Extended Diploma. This year is about extending your abilities and skills even further with an emphasis on professional practice, progression opportunities, specialist pathways and live briefs.

- 10. Characteristics and contexts in art and design
- 11. Preparation for progression in art and design
- 12. Engaging with an art and design audience
- 13. Project proposal and realisation in art and design

## **Entry Requirements**

4 GCSE passes (Grade C or above) including Art and Design or an Art related subject (e.g. Moving Image) and a portfolio of work or equivalent\*.

All applicants are interviewed and should prepare a portfolio of recent work that showcases their creative skills and abilities.

This can include evidence of drawing, painting, making, designing, digital artwork, sketchbooks, loose sheets, prep work, models and finished pieces created during your art and design studies and other related subject areas e.g. Graphic Products / Technology & Design / Moving Image Arts.
